# 2018 Summer Care Program

## Who can come?

Children who have completed kindergarten through sixth grade. There is also a separate program for your preschool age child.

## When?

The program begins Monday, June 4 and ends Friday, August 3. Our summer program is very flexible for attendance. You can choose the days of the week that you want for each of the nine weeks. You will only be charged for the days you sign up. Take that family vacation this summer and come to summer care too! Anyone who registers before May 4<sup>th</sup> will be guaranteed a spot. You may register after May 4<sup>th</sup> as space permits. We are open every day from 7 AM – 6 PM. We are closed on Wednesday, July 4<sup>th</sup>.

## How do I register?

Complete the Registration form and the Attendance/Account Activity form with the dates of planned attendance and return it to the office with your \$65 non-refundable enrollment fee. You will be charged for the days you sign up, regardless of your attendance. A field trip t-shirt is included in your registration, if you are registered on or before May 4<sup>th</sup>. After May 4<sup>th</sup> t-shirt prices are \$10. Please indicate your child's t-shirt size on the registration form. Please make checks payable to GLS. Please make separate checks for those in the preschool program. Checks returned from the bank will incur a \$35 fee.

- ◆ Morning: 8:00 AM - 12:00 PM
- ◆ Half Day: 7:00 AM – 1:00 PM OR 12:00 PM - 6:00 PM
- ◆ Full Day: 7:00 AM – 6:00 PM

- ◆ Field trip costs are over and above the daily fees. See reverse for details.
- ◆ Days can be exchanged as space permits with a 48-hour notice.
- ◆ No drop-ins are permitted. You must be signed up in advance.
- ◆ A \$35 late fee will be added to any balance not paid by August 3.
- ◆ Your summer tuition bill will be sent out weekly. You may pay weekly or monthly.
- ◆ **We will be enjoying Tuesday swim days** at the Modesto Fitness & Racquet Club (MFRC) here in Modesto. There will be a \$5.00 per Tuesday club fee (\$3.00 towards pool usage & \$2.00 towards our own personal lifeguard). If you have membership with MFRC, you may use your membership number to waive \$3.00 of the \$5.00 fee. June 12, 19, 26, July 10, 17, 24 & 31.
- ◆ On Grace Lutheran School's campus, our Thursday Adventure Activity Rotation will provide your child with a 2 1/2 hour rotating style experience in science, cooking, arts & crafts, physical & sporting type activities. June 7, 14, 21, 28, July 5, 12, 19, 26.
